



## **European Certification Body transition policy from SR EN ISO 9001:2008 to SR EN ISO 9001:2015 and from SR EN ISO 14001:2005 to SR EN ISO 14001:2015**

Taking into consideration the at the end of 2015 new revisions of the standards ISO 9001 Quality Management system and ISO14001 Environmental management System were published, in accordance with the agreement between International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and Committee on conformity assessment (CASCO) a 3 years transition period is required regarding granting certification in accordance with the requirements of SR EN ISO 9001:2015 and SR EN ISO 14001:2015 standards.

Way to achieve transition:

- The transition period ends at 01.10.2018.
- New clients can seek certification in accordance with the standards ISO 9001:2008 and ISO 14001:2005 until 01.10.2017. After this date certification will only be granted in accordance with ISO 9001:2015 and ISO 14001:2015.
- For existing clients, transition will be made during surveillance audits scheduled until 01.10.2017(date of the surveillance audit).
- For certifying the transition at the new standards it is necessary that all requirements of the standards ISO 9001: 2015 and ISO 14001:2005 to be implemented and at least one internal audit and management analysis must be performed.
- European Certification Body advises all existing and future clients to start the transition procedure to the requirement of the standards ISO9001:2015 and ISO14001: beginning with the first surveillance audit that is scheduled after the date of issuance of the present policy.
- European Certification Body has updated its methodologies and instructed the personnel regarding the provisions of the new standards.

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
